Cleaning Supervisor

General Duties & Responsibilities

- Supervise daily cleaning activities across classrooms, offices, toilets, corridors and other school facilities.
- Allocate tasks and monitor the performance of the cleaning team.
- Ensure cleaning schedules are followed and completed to required standards.
- Conduct regular inspections of all areas to maintain high cleanliness standards.
- Provide training and guidance to cleaning staff on best practices and safe use of cleaning products/equipment.
- Ensure sufficient stock of cleaning supplies and place orders as needed.
- Report maintenance or health & safety issues to the appropriate department.
- Maintain attendance records and report any staffing issues to management.



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• Ensure compliance with school policies, hygiene standards and health and safety regulations.

Skills and Competencies

- Proven experience in a supervisory cleaning role (preferably in an educational or similar institutional setting).
- Good leadership and people management skills.
- Excellent attention to detail and commitment to high standards.
- Strong organizational and time-management abilities.
- Ability to communicate effectively in English.
- Knowledge of cleaning chemicals, supplies and equipment.
- Understanding of health & safety and hygiene regulations.
