FINANCIAL CONDITIONS AND FEES: 2020-2021

As a non-profit organization VIS relies on tuition and other fees paid by parents for funding.

The administration fee of €300 is **non-refundable** and covers the costs of the school in considering and processing applications as well as administering the school's waiting lists for places.

A separate, **non-refundable** registration fee (as per the Fee schedule below) is payable upon acceptance of an offer of admission to the school and serves to guarantee a place for the coming year. Fees are set in Euros and the school only accepts payments in Euros, and it takes no responsibility for bank charges. School tuition fees are invoiced twice a year. Each invoice covers a period of five school months, the first being September to January and the second February to June. These fees must be paid prior to the commencement of each invoice period. Fees may be paid annually in advance if preferred. Tuition fees are due prior to the teaching period to which they relate and the school reserves the right to charge interest on arrears and consider limiting the access of pupils in respect of which fees remain unpaid.¹

To guarantee a place for subsequent years after, a deposit (deducted from fees) of €1,500 per student is payable by mid-March of each year. Kindly note that students will not be re-enrolled for next scholastic year unless all the fees of the present scholastic year are fully paid up.

Tuition fees will not be refunded for any reason for students who leave the school prior to the end of a semester. In the event that parent(s) or guardian(s) wish to withdraw and cancel a place or places from an upcoming semester of the student for whom they are responsible, which place or places would have already been reserved by them, such parent(s) or guardian(s) must give at least a semester's notice in writing to the Head of School. In the absence of the above {one semester's} notice, parents or guardians will be invoiced for the subsequent semester in full and for each such place(s) reserved for the student(s) for whom they are responsible.

In the event that during any one or more semesters, VIS is forced to close its physical premises and/or restrict access thereto and/or is otherwise unable to provide educational services at any of VIS' physical premises due to exceptional circumstances beyond VIS' control and/or otherwise due to force majeure (including but not limited to strikes, wars, terrorist attacks, earthquakes, floods, power outages and /or pandemics) any and/or all fees paid to VIS will not be refunded (not even on a pro rata basis) provided that VIS must have provided alternative educational services remotely (including but not limited to online learning or tuition) during any such period of time where the physical premises would have otherwise been open and/or accessible. Having said that, in such scenarios, the VIS **"Temporary – Payment Plan Policy Procedure for Intent to return Payment and Fees for Scholastic year 2020-2021 Due to Covid-19 repercussions"** may be availed of subject to the applicable terms and conditions contained therein.

Residency Program fees are due and payable for the full scholastic year prior to the arrival of the student at the school. Residency Program fees are non-refundable for withdrawal of students during any part of the scholastic year, Residency Program fees do not cover costs relating to any student remaining in Malta during the winter and spring breaks. Students are expected to return home during these periods with no school, at the cost of their parents or guardians.

A discount on fees is given to families with more than one student attending the school. A discount of €260 is given for two students, €800 for three students, and €1060 for four students.

¹ Interest at the maximum rate allowed by law will be charged for students having overdue accounts. Parents with overdue fees will be informed at least one week before the end of the first month of each semester. In the event that fees remain unpaid one month after school starts, the student in question will be suspended pending resolution of the matter. School records and report cards will not be issued for students having overdue accounts (Board policy re-endorsed March 29th, 2001).
