Head of School Report BOD Meeting – May 16 2022

1. COVID Update

- Students are now in larger bubbles per section
- Assemblies have returned (outside only)
- Uptick in cases has led to some cohorts going hybrid/online for a brief time (PK1 & Grade 1) to manage the situation and avoid a high impact of transmission.
- Covid protocols have been updated & communicated to the community

2. Substation & Newbuild update



- 2.1 The Substation roof (left image) is now on and the final stages ready for the Enemalta inspection. Once that is completed plans for the cross-road trenching can start.
- 2.2 The Newbuild Hoarding (right image) is being finalized to include a walk-way that allows people to walk from a pedestrian gate round to the basketball court. This will be plastered and

lights installed in the walkway. Actual work on the Newbuild will not start until School finishes in June.



3. School Activities

- Grade 10 (IGCSE) & 12 (DP) Exams continue in the off-site parish Hall exam rooms.
- Grade 12 High School Graduation will take place in person on May 27, for the first time in 2 years with parents and guests at the Fort
- Grade 5 Promotions Ceremony returns after 2 years with guests
- Field trips have commenced again for all grades
- Cohort social coffee meetings are taking place throughout April-June, to give parents an opportunity to meet each other, the Principal and Head of School
- Professional Development: All Educators participated in the third and final training on "Culturally Responsive Teaching & Learning" as part of our effort to have a better understanding of being culturally inclusive and embed these values into our practice.
- Principals Survey went out to the community in April feedback sessions have taken place with the Principals and will be incorporated into their annual evaluations.
- BeSmartOnline used our P.I.M. platform to give a parent presentation on safety online for children (13 parents attended). These topics are all covered in our PSHE & tech curriculum in addition SEDQA (Maltese safeguarding programme) have run sessions with our students.
